



P&G Pro Line Laundry Stain Remover Product Information Sheet

General Stain Remover Guidelines:

- Always pre-test for colorfastness in an inconspicuous area of the fabric.
- It is always best to pre-treat stains when they are fresh. Once a stain has been set into the fabric by the dryer it is much more difficult to remove.

Tide Multipurpose Stain Remover:

- Tide Multipurpose Stain Remover contains special ingredients to help remove stains from fabric.
- This product is the first line of defense for stain removal. Always try it first before using the Rust stain remover unless you know for sure it is rust.
- If it is a hotel or Nursing Home with maid carts – encourage the user to carry the Tide Multi-purpose stain remover on the cart and spot stains as they clear a room.
- In addition to the standard instructions – this product can safely be used as a pre-soak (~2oz./10gallons dilution).

Tide Rust Stain Remover:

- Primarily for use on rust spots. If it is truly rust the stain will disappear within moments after application. If it does not – the stain is unlikely rust.
- Product is also good for use on other Tannin based stains such as coffee, cola, and tea.

Note: Tide Rust Stain Remover should never be added directly into the wash cycle.
